08/0829        Bramley Grange Flats

Replacement of three garage block by pitched roof version. As they appear a great improvement, No Objection

08/0890        Hove Cottage 11 Firs Avenue

Extensions and alterations to form 2 storey dwelling. No floor plans available and could overlook at the rear. However no objection to good comprehensive scheme to add a first floor to existing bungalow.

08/0904/0921 Bramley Motors.

Phil Scattergood declared an interest as he was joint owner of local property.

No objection to demolition of Brick Garage Block at rear of Forest Gallery, next to Brewery cottages and replacement with slightly smaller and slightly taller Oak Timber Building to give reduced number of slightly larger garages and toilet with store and mess room over.

08/0922        Robertsons

Revised scheme to convert existing Three/Four Bedroom Flat, into one two bedroom flat with second one Bedroom flat on top floor. No alterations to left side, One Extra Window on Right and lose two Windows from the Front elevation. As Robertson's had previously indicated that parking spaces would be provided at the rear the Society had no objection

08/0803/4     Bramley Manor West (Lace Evans)

No objection to upgrading existing store to utility room, replacement of Green house with Sun Room and building of extra garden store all joined by traditional wall and guttering.

08/0797        Threshers (11 High St.)  
Change from retail to Dental surgery. No objection though regrettable to lose a shop.

08/0790        Wintershall Cottage  
No real objection to retrospective application for stables and outbuildings on the south of the property as they are appropriate rural requirements for the new size of property!

08/0778        Churton Cottage Links Rd.  
No problem with re-siting proposed Garage set back on to south side of property.

08/0796        Cobble Cottage, Thorncombe Street  
No objection to revised plan for changing room etc. Still quite large but much smaller than originally proposed having reduced the Cellar, lost the first floor and lowered the roof line.
